A parent's guide to the GCSE reforms

Between September 2015 and September 2017, new GCSE courses have been introduced by the Government which will impact on all students currently in Year 11 and below. There will also be changes to the way in which the examinations are graded. This means that by 2020 all GCSEs will be graded on a numerical scale.

The main features of the new GCSEs are:

- A new grading scale of 9 to 1 will be used, with 9 being the top grade. This will allow greater differentiation between students and will help distinguish the new GCSEs from previous versions.
- Assessment will be mainly by exam, with other types of assessment used only where they are needed to test essential skills.
- There will be new, more demanding content, which has been developed by the Government and the exam boards.
- Courses will no longer be divided into different modules and students will take all their exams in one period at the end of their course.

These changes will affect your child as follows:-

- Your child will take the new GCSE courses in English Language, English Literature, Mathematics and Science
- Depending on their GCSE options choices, they will also take new courses in Computer Science, Geography, History, French, Physical Education, Religious Studies, and Technology. Grades will be shown as 9-1.
- The vocational subjects we offer including Acting, Art, Child Care & Music will also have an externally examined element to them which brings them more in line with other subjects.
