Yorkshire Wildlife Park Trip

Please inform College if you will be providing your child or if you would like College to provide this (lunch can be paid for via the School Gateway App).

Students are advised to bring a packed lunch. Students receiving Free School Meals will be catered for and your child is asked to collect this from the KS3 Canteen prior to departure on the day.

We will not be going in the gift shop or café, so please ensure your child does not bring any money.

We are really looking forward to taking the children as they have worked hard, and it will be a lovely way to end the year.
