
Attendance

Good attendance for all students is crucial but it is even more vital in year 11 as the clear link between good exam results and good attendance can be seen using the Year 11 GCSE exam results from this Summer. Students who attended over 95% (that means had less than 9 days absence from college) had a 76% of achieving a good pass in both English and Maths. This drops to less than 14% if attending less than 85%. At the start of a new academic year the priority for all students is to be in every lesson everyday. Even a small drop below 95% has a drastic effect on academic outcomes. Don't let poor attendance be the difference between your child having a range of options at Post 16 or one which has only limited ones.
