Road Safety

We request that all parents/carers support the College by reminding their child about safety when walking to school and crossing roads.

At Minsthorpe Community College safety messages have been delivered to all year groups, which include road safety.

However, we are receiving reports from the public about students putting themselves at risk! We need to work together to ensure that all our young people are aware of the dangers and hazards around them.

Please reaffirm the message that they should not indulge in horseplay near, or when crossing, a road. They should only cross roads at safe places - avoid crossing at junctions, between parked cars and always look in both directions. Making sure that they are alert and not distracted by devices.

Please could we also take this opportunity to remind all parents to be especially considerate as to where they park, when dropping off and collecting children at the start and end of the day.

This is to ensure that visibility for young people and drivers is as clear as possible to avoid accidents occurring.
